

We understand the use of rock and were pioneers in the use of geotextile sand bags in Western Australia. We can also assist in the development of effective sand nourishment programs.
- Asset management we are experienced in the condition assessment of marine and coastal structures. We are able to guide you through the prioritisation of repairs, development of maintenance strategies and optimisation of ongoing monitoring. Our services include condition inspections/ratings, fair value cost estimates, GIS database management, strategic asset management (SAM) plans and whole of life cycle costing and optimisation.
